Board President Message



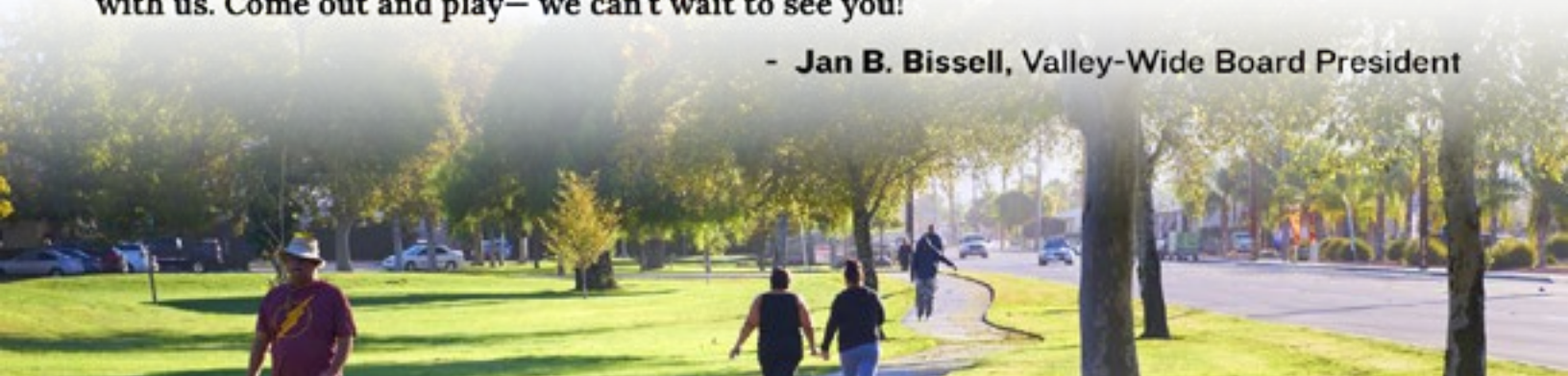

Valley-Wide Recreation and Park District is an independent special district created to provide park and recreation services for an area that now includes more than 275,000 residents. Our boundaries encompass an 800-square-mile area, which includes the cities of Hemet, Menifee and San Jacinto and the unincorporated communities of Aguanga, French Valley, Winchester, Temecula, and Valle Vista. In the early 1970s, a group of San Jacinto Valley residents teamed up to promote a Park District to offer recreational opportunities for children, adults and seniors. The District was approved by voters and authorized on July 27, 1972. Since its creation, the District has grown from one park to 83 parks and facilities, many of which have received national and state recognition for their design, innovation and style, as well as youth and adult sports leagues

and hundreds of educational and recreational classes and programs. Valley-Wide parks attract an estimated 4 million visitors per year.

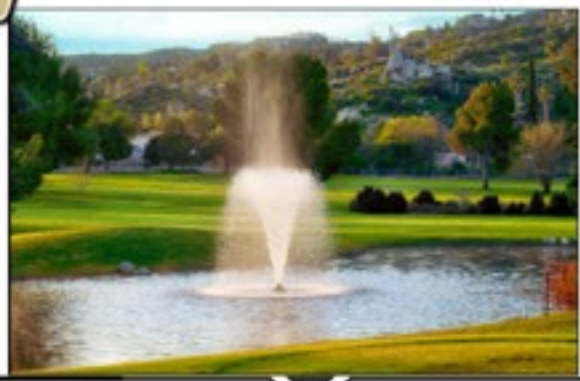

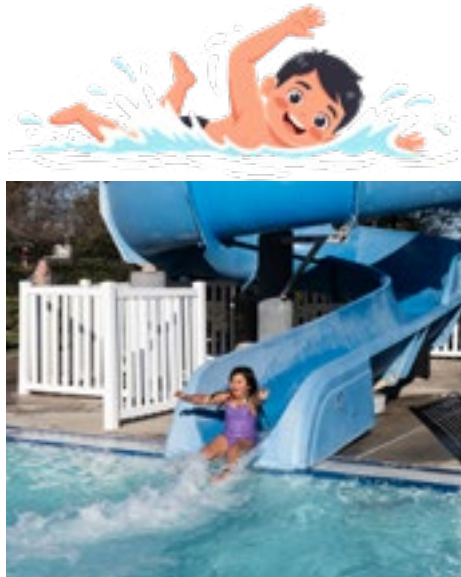
